

5 Compact kitchen ideas





Nothing should limit creating your dream kitchen space, including size. While tiny spaces present more design challenges than larger ones, there are plenty of ways to create a small kitchen that's functional and stylish.

Choose light colours

Light, neutral colours, such as grey and white, are popular colour options to make small kitchens appear larger. Lighten up your space by pairing it with crisp white tiles and light coloured worksurfaces.

Colourful walls




Curved edges

Warm tones




Statement worktops
